Definitions

BSA means Bath Strings Academy

CMP means Chamber Music Programme

'Term' means Terms 1 & 2 (Autumn), Terms 3 & 4 (Spring), Terms 5 & 6 (Summer)

'Invoicing period' means Terms 1 & 2 (Autumn) or Terms 3 & 4 (Spring) or Terms 5 & 6 (Summer)

'Half a term' means terms 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6

'External venue' means any venue other than those specified for rehearsals

'Participant' means the young person who is taking part in CMP activities run by BSA

'Parent/Carer' means the person granting permission for the 'Participant' to attend CMP and the person who is responsible for paying the tuition fees

Terms & Conditions

1. Sessions for the Chamber Music Programme (CMP) will be invoiced in advance each large Term.
2. Tuition fees are non-refundable and invoices should be paid in full on or before the due date indicated on the invoice and in advance of sessions received.
3. The number of sessions each term will vary and during the academic year there will be between 30 – 33 sessions. BSA will inform you of the number of sessions and the dates for the term at the start of each invoicing period.
4. Fees for CMP tuition are published on the [BSA website](#) with sibling discounts, second group discounts and bursaries available. From time to time it may be necessary to adjust our fees and the Parent/Carer will be given written notice, half a term in advance of any changes being applied.
5. Fees for CMP will include an additional end of term concert fee which is included in each invoicing period and is used to defray the extra venue and staffing costs incurred.

6. In cases where CMP players are rehearsing and/or performing as part of a larger group and/or across an extended time period (more than 1 hour), an additional administration charge may be applied.
7. Additional fees may apply to additional concert dates and concert facilitation which takes place outside of the CMP programme dates and/or at external venues.
8. The rehearsal venues for CMP are as published on our website and are subject to change according to availability. BSA will endeavour to give as much notice as possible when a venue change is necessary.
9. If the Parent/Carer wishes to cancel tuition at CMP on behalf of the Participant the Parent/Carer is required to give written notice no later than the sixth session of an invoicing period.
10. The Parent/Carer is required to complete the Participant [CMP Registration Form](#) of which the terms and conditions agreed to therein are legally binding.
11. If the Parent/Carer fails to provide the required notice this may result in fees for the following invoicing period being charged in full.
12. BSA reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time and the Parent/Carer will receive written notice in advance of any changes being applied.
13. These terms and conditions are legally binding.
14. BSA is territorially based in the UK and as such is subject exclusively to English and Welsh Law.
