

Scholarships are available for exceptional musicians who demonstrate a passion for, and a strong commitment to musical study. Applications are invited from players of the violin, viola, 'cello or double bass; awards are made on the basis of audition and a written application.

Summer Academy Chamber Music Awards

Applications for Chamber Music Awards for our Summer Academy are welcome from individuals or pre-formed string quartets playing at grade 7 level and above in two categories:

- Age 13 and under
- Age 14 – 18

The Music Award consists of:

- A guaranteed place on the Chamber Music strand of our Summer Academy (August 28th – 30th), with three days of coaching from the **Morven Bryce, Dan Shilladay & Nick Roberts, subsidised at a rate of 50%**. Music Award holders will be placed in a chamber group with players of a similar age with a comparable level of experience, and where possible, with other Award holders.
- Free attendance and coaching at a one-day chamber music workshop during the academic year 2019-2020.
- The opportunity to perform in Bath Strings Academy selected showcase concerts during the academic year 2019 -2020. There will be free participation for up to two events at which scholarship students may perform. Event venues may include Wiltshire Music Centre in Bradford-on-Avon, St George's Concert Hall in Bristol and other performance spaces in and around the locality.

The total fee payable, after the scholarship award is £200.

Application Process:

Candidates are invited to submit a **video recording** of two contrasting pieces, with or without accompaniment. Each piece should last no more than 5 minutes, and may be an extract from a longer work.

A **written application** should accompany the video submission, using the application form provided. We require all recordings to be hosted on a website (e.g YouTube or SoundCloud). Once this has been done, recording links added into two boxes provided on the application form.

Applications will be assessed by a panel including an independent adjudicator. Following assessment of the submissions, a shortlist of candidates will be invited to take part in a short interview, either in person or via video link (Skype or similar) to discuss the candidate's musical interests and ambitions.

The deadline for applications is Sunday 16th June 2019

Successful Applicants:

Successful candidates will be informed of their selection no later than **Saturday 29th June**.

Following acceptance, candidates will be required to complete a booking application via our ticketing platform using a 100% discount code that will be provided. This is so that we can collate all participant information in one place.
